

YOUR IMPORT DUTY AND VAT INVOICE EXPLANATORY NOTES

- **1. Invoice No:** The number of this invoice, to be quoted in the event of enquiries.
- 2. Date of Invoice: The date this invoice was raised.
- Customs Entry Declaration Number (MRN): H.M. Revenue and Customs reference number.
- 4. DHL Waybill: The waybill or shipment reference number.
- 5. Customer Number: If you do not have an existing customer number with DHL we will have allocated a DHL Customer Number for this importation. This is not a formal account and it does not have shipping facilities.
- 6. Shipper's name and country: The sender's details.
- Description of Goods: Brief description of the shipment and what it contained
- Taric Code: The code which is used to assess the duty to be paid (if applicable).
- 9. Shipment Origin: The country of despatch.
- **10. Customs Procedure Code:** This code identifies the Customs regime to which your goods were entered.
- **11. Statistical Value Duty:** The value used for calculation of Customs Duty e.g. shipper's invoice plus freight value.
- Customs Duty Rate: The Customs Duty percentage for the goods.
- **13.** Customs Duty Payable: The amount of Customs Duty payable on your shipment.
- 14. Statistic Value VAT: Customs normally expect this to be the total of items 11, 13, 19 and the cost of transit within UK borders, liable for VAT only
- **15. VAT Rate:** The Customs VAT percentage for the goods.
- 16. VAT Payable: The amount of VAT payable on your shipment.
- Statistic Value Other Levy: The value used for calculation of the Customs excise.
- Other Levy Rate: The percentage of excise or anti dumping levied.
- Other Levy Payable: The amount of excise / anti dumping payable on your shipment.
- **20. Duty Tax Importer:** The cost of DHL arranging Customs clearance.
- **21. Importers VAT No:** If you are registered for VAT you should be able to reclaim the VAT amount indicated on this invoice.

NOTE – REJECTED IMPORTS: If you need to return your goods you must contact H.M. Revenue & Customs beforehand. Failure to do so may result in these charges being irrecoverable.

POSTPONED VAT ACCOUNTING (PVA) NOTIFICATION: From

- At the Bank: You can make a payment directly at the bank using an invoice giro slip or by quoting DHL bank details:
 Sort Code 40-02-50, DHL Bank Account number 91406396. Please ensure the bank has entered your Invoice number and/or Customer number in their system as a 'Customer Reference', to ensure we can match your payment with your invoice. Please allow 4 working days for the payment to clear your account.
